Music festival planned for Mount View

The organisers of Sydney's SASH Sundays are planning to bring a three-day music festival to a Mount View property in May.

Subject to council approval, the SASH Sleepout—an electronic jazz and acoustic music and arts festival—will be held at Cedars Mount View (on Mitchells Road) from May 23 to 25 and will cater to up to 1500 people.

Event organiser Paved Way has been running SASH Sundays at Sydney hotels for more than two years.

Their aim for the SASH Sleepout is to "offer patrons an experience unlike anything that can be offered in the constraints of Sydney's CBD".

It will feature acoustic music and

down-tempo house music from artists from around the world including England, France, Sweden, Romania and Spain with support from some of Australia's best acts.

The organisers estimate the festival will bring \$150,000 to the Cessnock community.

Paved Way will donate a portion of the proceeds of tickets sold to Dr. Charlie Teo's Cure For Life charity, and will also make a donation to the local Rural Fire Service for their assistance with parking procedures.

The development application is on public exhibition at council's administration building and website until Wednesday, February 12.
